#### STATEMENT OF FAITH

#### 1. The Word of God

We believe that the Bible is the word of God, consists of the Old and New Testaments, was written under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, is without error in the original manuscripts, and is the ultimate authority for the believer's life (2 Timothy 3:16, 2 Peter 1: 19-21, Hebrews 1:1-2).

#### 2. The Trinity

We believe that there is One true and living God, eternally existing in three persons; that these are equal in divine perfection and execute distinct and harmonious offices in the work of creation, providence, and redemption (John 4:24, John 1:1, Luke 3:21-22, Matthew 28:19, Colossians 2:9, John 15:26-27).

#### 3. God The Father

We believe that God the Father is eternally self-existent, righteous, sovereign, perfect in holiness. He perfectly foreknows all that shall come to pass. He is all-powerful, entirely good, and omnipresent. Through creation, the Father seeks to bring glory to Himself. He concerns Himself mercifully in the affairs of men. He hears prayer. He graciously chooses to save all those who come to Him in repentance of sin and through the Gospel of Jesus Christ (Genesis 1:1, Romans 3:23-25, 1 Corinthians 8:6, Psalm 33:9, Ephesians 4:6, Malachi 2:10, Revelation 4:8, Psalm 34:17-18, Jeremiah 32:17, Jeremiah 33:3)

#### 4. Jesus Christ

We believe Jesus Christ is God, and has existed eternally in the Trinity. He is God's only begotten Son, conceived by the Holy Spirit. We believe in His virgin birth, sinless life, miracles, and teachings. We believe in his death on the cross, by which He bore the Father's wrath against sin in our stead, and in His resurrection by which He seals His victory over death and sin and by which He gives life to all who follow Him. We believe He has ascended and is seated at God's right hand, making perpetual intercession for the Saints. We believe in his coming visible return to consummate His eternal kingdom (John 14:6, 1 Thessalonians 5:9, John 1:1-4, Hebrews 7:25, Hebrews 1:3-6, Matthew 24:4-5, Matthew 24:30-31, John 11:25-26, Colossians 1:13-20, Isaiah 9:6, John 20:1, Luke 24:2,6, Romans 3:25, Philippians 2:10).

#### 5. The Holy Spirit

We believe that the Holy Spirit is God. The Holy Spirit actively regenerates sinners. He indwells, sanctifies, and empowers every believer, and intercedes on their behalf to the Father. He manifests spiritual gifts in believers' lives that enable them to further the Kingdom and edify the Church (Romans 8:26-27, John 14-16, 1 Corinthians 12:1-11, Hebrews 2:3-4, Judges 3:10, Luke 24:45, John 4:24, John 3:6-8, Acts 2, John 15:26-27, Romans 8:2-6).

#### 6. The Necessity and Nature of Regeneration

We believe that God created man in His own image. Thereafter man sinned, resulting in physical, spiritual, and eternal death, which is separation from God, and in the corruption of God's image. As a consequence all humans (excluding Jesus) have been both born in sin and have chosen sin and are therefore under God's righteous

condemnation. We believe that those who repent and forsake sin and trust Jesus Christ as Savior are regenerated by the Holy Spirit and become new creatures, delivered from condemnation and receive eternal life in the presence of God (Ezekiel 36:26, Titus 3:5, Psalm 51:5, 1 John 3:9, Galatians 2:20, Ephesians 2:8, Ephesians 4:22-24, John 6:44, Colossians 3:10, 2 Corinthians 5:17, Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23, Genesis 3:14-19, John 3:3).

#### 7. The Church

The Church is the bride and the body of Christ, for whom Christ died. She consists of all those who turn from sin and trust in Christ as Savior. Jesus is the head of the Church. The Church has been charged to carry out the work of the Kingdom and to spread the Gospel on Earth through evangelism, global missions, and good deeds. The Church is unified in mission and purpose, but consists of many parts diverse in gifts and responsibilities (1 Corinthians 12:12, Hebrews 10:25, Ephesians 5:23-27, Romans 12:4-5, John 10:14-15, Matthew 28:19-20, Acts 1:8, Revelation 19:7, Matthew 25:35-36).

#### 8. Christian Conduct

We believe that Christians are responsible to work out their salvation by subjecting their lives to the authority of Scripture and committing themselves to fellowship with other believers in the Church (Acts 2:42-47, 1 John 3:9, Romans 6:1, Philippians 2:12-16, 1 Thessalonians 5:12-25, Philippians 1:27, 1 Timothy 1:5).

#### 9. The Ordinances

We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ has instituted the following ordinances for His Church. First, we believe in the responsibility of the Church to baptize new believers. Second, we believe in the responsibility of the Church to commemorate Christ's atoning sacrifice through frequent participation in the breaking of bread and the taking of the cup as a symbol of Christ's work on the cross (1 Corinthians 11:17-34, Matthew 28:19, Romans 6:3-4, Luke 22:14-23, Matthew 3:13-17).

#### 10. Religious Liberty

We believe that every human being has direct relations with God, and is responsible to God alone in all matters of faith; that each church is independent and must be free from interference by any ecclesiastical or political authority; that therefore Church and State must be kept separate as having different functions, each fulfilling its duties free from dictation or patronage of the other (1 Timothy 2:5, Romans 14:7-9, 12).

#### 11. Church Cooperation

We believe that local churches can best promote the cause of Jesus Christ by cooperating with one another in a denominational organization. Such an organization, whether a regional or district conference, exists and functions by the will of the churches. Cooperation in a conference is voluntary and may be terminated at any time (Acts 15:36,41, 16:5, 1 Corinthians 16:1, Galatians 1:1-3, Revelation 1:4, 10, 11).

#### 12. The Last Things

We believe in the personal and visible return of the Lord Jesus Christ to earth and the establishment of His kingdom. We believe in the resurrection of the body, the final judgment, the eternal felicity of the righteous and the endless suffering of the wicked in separation from God (Matthew 16:27, Mark 14:62, John 14:3, Acts 1:11, Philippians 3:20, 1 Thessalonians 4:15, 2 Timothy 4:1, Titus 2:13, 1 Corinthians 4:5, I Corinthians 15, 2 Thessalonians 1:7-10, Revelation 20:4-6, 11-15).
