Camp Rules and Guidelines

- GCC is a Christian camp and all rules are to help us to reflect Christ in our conduct.
- Please respect all camp properties just as you would at the church you attend. We ask you to assist in keeping the grounds clean of trash. Cans are provided camp wide to contain debris.
- All of the above rules are designed to provide a Christian atmosphere, a safe and healthy environment, and provide for the respect of the camp and facilities. Please see to it that all campers are aware of these rules before your event begins.
- MEDICINAL MARIJUANA, illegal drugs, alcohol, knives, ANY form of tobacco, guns, skateboards, and fireworks are not permitted.
- If property or equipment is damaged, your group will be held responsible for any cost incurred for repair or replacement.
- GCC requires two adult sponsors in each dorm room. Sponsors must be at least 18 years old with a background check.
- Shoes must be worn at all times (unless a camper is in the pool, on sand volleyball courts, or on Rec field).
- No clothing which is revealing, suggestive, or advertises alcohol or tobacco products will be allowed.
- Swimsuits must be modest – no bikini- or monokini-style or a colored t-shirt must be worn while at the pool. Lifeguards have discretion and can eject anyone not properly clothed from pool area.
- Shaving cream fights, water fights, etc. will not be tolerated. A group doing such in or near enough a building to cause damage, will face a charge of at least \$100.
- No use of the Zip line, laser tag, inflatables, water slide, or pool is allowed unless GCC authorized, trained personnel are present.
- Campers are not allowed to enter dorms of campers of the opposite sex. Campers will use gender-at-birth dorms only.
- Campers are not allowed to leave the campgrounds while at camp unless under direction of lead sponsor.
- Campers must attend all scheduled sessions and activities.

- Campers are not allowed to ride in or on any vehicle at camp. Sponsors may ride in vehicles driven by approved sponsors.
- Campers are not allowed to share ANY medication belonging to them with any other camper.
- No food and/or drink items are allowed in Chapel or Sleeping areas.
- Counselors must accompany campers leaving dorms for any reason after lights out.
- All campers must be accompanied by a sponsor to the First Aid Station for treatment.
- Pastors & sponsors will be responsible for the conduct of their campers. Extreme discipline problems will be brought to the Camp Administrator &/or appropriate GCC leadership.
- No unauthorized person will be allowed on grounds. Visitors are restricted to approved church staff with background checks.
- Cell phones may be used ONLY to communicate with parents & are limited to use in your cabin.

Drop-Off /Pick-Up Schedule

- Please arrive at the church at 11:30am on Monday, July 22. We will eat a quick lunch, load up all luggage and leave for camp.
- We will arrive back at the church around noon on Thursday, July 25.

Suggested Packing List

- Clothes for Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday of camp (shirts, shorts, underwear, socks)

- Any prescription medications (in original container clearly marked with child's name put in a baggie and check them in with an adult sponsor)

- Bath Towels and swimming towel
- Soap/Shampoo
- Toothbrush/Toothpaste
- Deodorant
- Refillable Water Bottle
- Closed toe shoes
- Sandals/Flip-flops
- Laundry Bag for dirty clothes
- Extra \$5 or \$10 for Sugar Shack/Souvenirs

Please don't bring:

- Over-the-counter medications (We will provide if needed)
- Electronics, cell phones, video games, iPods, etc.
- Anything you don't want to get lost or broken

Additional Details

- Free time will include Laser Tag, Miniature Golf, Basketball, Tetherball, Disc golf and Sugar Shack games, Screamer Swing, and Rock Wall (as indicated on schedule). Zip line will be scheduled during free time. All staff are certified and trained in the areas they operate.
- Team Points are earned throughout the week. Churches are divided into blue, green, or yellow teams upon arrival. They are earned through: scripture memory; sharing ones testimony; service; scavenger hunts; and attitude. Bracelets are given as points by staff members. Bracelets are then collected each morning at Celebration and tallied.

- The Sugar Shack will be open during the day and after evening chapel. Concessions and gift shop items may be purchased with Sugar Shack cards. Extra cards may be purchased for \$5.

Please read, understand, complete and return with your registration.

- I must attend all worship services and family group times. I will be on time for all events!
- I understand that no girls are allowed in the boy's dorms and no boys are allowed in the girl's dorms.
- I understand that no one is to leave his/her dorm at or after designated bedtime, unless there is an emergency.
- I understand that I am Not Allowed to bring or have the following items (or similar items) on the bus to camp or while at camp:
 - Handheld Electronics, MP3 Players, Cell Phone, iPods', iPads, Laptops, Weapons, and last but not least Fireworks!
 - Every sponsor's cell phone number is listed in your information packets. Parents if you need to reach your student at any time please feel free to contact any of the numbers listed and we will make sure we get you in touch with your child. Also, if any student wishes to contact their parents while at camp, they will be allowed to use a sponsor's phone to do so as long as it is during a free time during the day or during the free time after the nightly service.
- I will wear MODEST clothing. (Remember this is a CHURCH CAMP.) I will follow the dress code. The dress code begins on Monday morning before we leave for camp. If my clothing is inappropriate & I am asked to change by a sponsor, I will cooperate without question. If I have a question about my clothing, I will ask a sponsor before we leave for camp.
- I will respect authority. I WILL NOT mouth or talk back to a sponsor if they are asking me to do something.
- I will communicate all problems and concerns with a sponsor in a calm respectful manor.
- I understand that there are no forms of mistreating other people and/or their personal belongings, younger students, or students from other churches that will be tolerated. We are going to camp and we are to honor God by our behaviors.
- NO PRANKS!!! YOU WILL BE SENT HOME FOR SUCH CONDUCT!
