Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

SCRIPTURE

Acts 2:1-13

SESSION SUMMARY

In this week's session, we see that the disciples obeyed Jesus's instruction to wait on the Holy Spirit, and we see the fulfillment of Jesus's promise to send this great gift. The Holy Spirit filled them and enabled them to share the truth about Jesus with everyone. Here are the main points:

- Jesus's disciples witness God's plan (Acts 2:1).
- Jesus's disciples are filled with the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:2-5).
- Jesus's disciples reveal God's works (Acts 2:6-13).

CONVERSATION QUESTIONS

- When is it easy for our family to get so focused on following God's commands that we forget about His grace and following the Holy Spirit?
- · Do we tend to believe God still works miracles or that they're a thing of the past? Why?
- What evidence shows the Holy Spirit is active in our family?

FAMILY CHALLENGE

On small slips of paper write some common phrases a beginner might learn in a foreign language. Fold them up and place them in a bowl. Allow each family member to draw a slip of paper and choose a language to research. Give a few minutes for everyone to learn how to say their phrase in their chosen languages. Then, share the phrase (the best you can) in that language, and see if anyone can guess your phrase—or even the language you're speaking! Talk about how impossible it is to understand a different language without translation. Discuss how God provided even for this in sending His Holy Spirit.
